Dear Parents / Carers,

We hope you're continuing to keep healthy and safe. The arrangements for 'Distance Learning' continue. Various activities are offered by the teachers through the children's Hwb accounts and Google Classrooms. We would like to continue to encourage children to venture the suggested tasks, however we are not demanding that the children complete a long list of tasks. We have taken this into great consideration whilst planning and setting a range of possible activities tasks for specific age groups. **There is no requirement for you and your child to follow any set timetable for activities or tasks, as we wish to give families the flexibility to complete any tasks or activities in a framework that works for you.** Please also remember, the use of ICT is not required to complete every activity, as they can also be completed with pen and paper. We would also encourage all pupils to be as active as possible mentally and physically on a daily basis but understand that it may be difficult in reality.

**Arrangements for e.mail and collect** – We will be offering the e.mail and collect arrangement over next week. **The arrangement for collecting resources you may have requested will be available during the week beginning 8.6.20.** Following the same arrangements as before, you will need to communicate with your child's classteacher through e.mail if you do require any resources.(please ensure any requests are sent to the classteacher through e.mail before 3.30 on the previous day) Any resources requested such as reading books, paper, will be available for a collection from the box located outside the hall door.

Once again, a box labelled with the words '**Drop off**' will also be located outside the hall door. We would appreciate for any school reading books which the children may have finished reading to be returned, so that these can be available for others, as the school has only a limited supply of reading books to loan out to the children. Please label with the child's name. Thank you.
