The Six Learning Areas:



Health and Wellbeing: *The children's health and wellbeing is a key part of our activities in class. We will be giving attention to developing the children's confidence and independence. During circle times we will be encouraging the children to express their feelings and emotions. Athletics, movement and playground games will be the content of our P. E. lessons and we look forward to teach the children the importance of relaxing as well as seeing their competitive side during sports day!*

Language, Literacy and Communication: *There is no better feeling than seeing the children learning the Welsh language and falling in love with its culture. We promote this through a variety of activities from singing to learning weekly Welsh phrases. We use phonic programmes such as 'Tric a Chlic' to develop the children's reading skills and we give higher-order reading tasks to the older children within the department. Going into the children's imaginative world is very important to us*

to stimulate them to write and we take every opportunity for the children to use different writing forms and working cross curricular in thematic work. We also teach the children to communicate through Makaton and we concentrate on a new sign weekly.



Mathematics and Numeracy: We will be concentrating on developing the children's recognition and understanding the value of numbers, sequencing numbers and adding and subtracting with the older children this term. We will be taking advantage of every opportunity for the children to work practically, cross-curricular and to learn through play; from handling money in the 'ice cream shop' to counting legs on the octopus!



Expressive Arts: As the saying goes; 'singing feeds the soul' and we will be singing thematic songs, playing musical games and learning songs from the 'croesi bont' programme. They will create sounds of water using instrument they have made and listen to different varieties of music following the theme water. We will imitate famous artists' work such as Claude Monet as well as experimenting creatively whilst doing arts and crafts.

Science and Technology: Sali Sws needs help to learn about the environment and her habitat! We will explore the world around us and learn how we can help recycle and improve the local area. We will ignite the children's curiosity and nurture their ability to learn independently through a variety of exciting activities, investigations and experiments. We will be applying the digital competence framework through activities such as data collecting, coding, creating, editing and learning about online safety.

Humanities: We look forward to learning about endangered animals and those that need our help. We will take advantage of every opportunity to learn in the local outdoor area and improving a range of skills cross-curricularly in the Forest School. We will be celebrating a variety of cultures and religions through stories and songs.
