Dear Parents / Carers,

**Expectations while on the school site** - I would like to thank everyone for their co-operation with regards to various arrangements which have been put in place during the pandemic. The current daily arrangements will continue after the Easter break, as well as other arrangements including wearing face coverings when on the school site, one parent/carer to drop-off and collect, avoid arriving more than 5 minutes before your child's start / collection times, and also to continue to follow social distancing arrangements.
