Dear Parents / Carers,

School uniform

As notified at the end of the Summer term, I would like to remind you of the school uniform arrangements. In line with the school policy, the current school uniform is navy blue trousers/skirt, navy blue polo shirt and school sweatshirt or cardigan. **All pupils are asked to wear black shoes. High heels and labelled trainers should not be worn as part of school uniform.**

The children will also expected to wear the school PE kit for PE lessons, which includes a **navy blue polo shirt and navy blue shorts**. Suitable trainers will be required for outdoor activities. School uniform should be clearly labelled with your child's name. Football kits should not be worn for PE lessons.

JEWELLERY - Jewellery is not part of the school uniform and should not be worn in school. Items such as bracelets, rings, necklaces, earrings (small studs only acceptable) should be kept at home. For any child who wears ear studs, for health and safety reasons, these should be covered with a plaster for PE activities.

If you are uncertain with regarding to what is acceptable, then please contact the school to check.
